EQUIPMENT POLICY

Calgary Rockies FC will provide extra equipment for players to use during the Season Launch Period for training, technical and academy sessions. After this time period, Calgary Rockies and its coaching staff will not be responsible to provide extra equipment; the Honus will be on the player.

It will be mandatory for each player to possess the following equipment after the initial Season Launch period:

- **An appropriately sized ball** (U7-8: size 3, U9-12: size 4, U13+: size 5). Rockies balls are preferred. Incorrectly sized balls will not be allowed at any session.
- **A Rockies backpack.** We do not allow other backpacks at our sessions as the top pocket of each backpack is used at a medical pouch in case of emergency. All of our coaches are trained to check this pocket before any other location and often in an emergency, each second matters. Epi pens, puffers and other medication is required to be kept in this pocket and thus we ask that only Rockies backpack are used in the club.
- **Rockies Practice and Academy training gear:** Grey Training top, blue shorts and socks
- **Rockies Performance Technical Session/IDP/Group gear:** Black Performance Training Top, Black shorts and socks
- **Rockies TrackTops and/or Hoodies** worn to each game event.

Gear from other clubs may not be brought to Rockies events.

New Player Combos

Players new to the club need to purchase the New Player Combo from the club store. New players are defined as those who have not played in the full CMSA program over the last two seasons (indoor and outdoor – Lite does not apply).

Jersey, short and sock replacement are always responsibility of the parent or guardian and can be purchased from the club store. The jersey number is always assigned by the club.
